Note: to qualify for Gift Aid, what you pay in income or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount we will claim in the tax year.

If you pay a lower rate (10 per cent or 20 per cent), HRAP can still claim back 28p for each £1 you donate, provided you pay enough tax to cover the claim in the tax year you make the gift(s).

If you are a higher rate taxpayer, if you declare your donations on your tax return, you can claim a rebate based on the difference between the higher rate and the basic rate when you fill in your self-assessment form. Self-assessment tax forms allow you to nominate a charity to receive any rebate that you are due. The Inland Revenue will pass the repayment directly to the charity. By doing this you could increase the value each £1 donation to £1.51.
